General discussion on how we can assist those affected by storm

Local Disaster Emergency Declaration

Cameron Stanford, Mike Clements and Sheriff Klingler were present.

The Disaster Emergency Declaration is being signed to cover the county for liability issues and to assist the County if claims are filed or if damage repair issues total more than the County can pay.

Sheriff Klingler wanted to stress that Cameron is the Emergency Management Administrator. Mike is a resource to get the help we need from the State and be of assistance to Cameron. We need an inventory list of available equipment so we know what we can use in an emergency and the employees we can require to come in an emergency.

Many people were helping in neighborhoods, and college students helping others. The LDS church also checked on everyone in their wards. They BYU-I Center and the Jr. High School were set up as emergency shelters, but only had a few people show up for help. Mike stated that at the EOC meeting everyone acted as they had been trained.

Commissioner Ricks made a motion to sign Resolution #376 Emergency Declaration covering the disaster. Commissioner Smith seconded and voting was unanimous.

Solid Waste fees for those affected by storm

An arrangement has been made with the C & D site west of Rexburg to take flood debris. Commissioner Weber has talked to restoration companies and asked them to pass the savings on to members of the community they are serving. The Jefferson County Commissioners are considering giving us some relief for the extra refuse that will be dumped as a result of the flood.

Servpro Superintendents stopped by to explain the process of drying out the Administration Building. They were asked to submit estimates of repair and procedures.

Commissioner Ricks made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 12:20 p.m. Commissioner Weber seconded and voting was unanimous.
